

Quality Policy

The products we deliver shall comply with the express and implicit requirements of our customers in terms of road safety, operational safety and reliability, operating economy, ergonomics and exterior design, and also comply with the requirements of the authorities.

The products shall be delivered in the correct number and on the agreed date.

The Zero Fault principle shall be applied in VBG, and this shall be achieved through preventive measures and continuous improvements in all functions.

Environmental Policy

VBG, which conducts operations in the vehicle industry, shall protect the external and internal environment. Our activities, both within and outside the company, shall reduce the environmental impact of both new and existing processes and products. This is achieved through measures to economise on resources, preventive measures to reduce pollution, and continuous improvements with, from an economic perspective, the best available technology.

Operations shall be conducted in such a way that:

- compliance with applicable legislation is achieved by a good margin, and the impact on the environment from unintentional discharge of materials and energy is prevented, as well as a reduction in noise levels.
- All employees shall be well-informed of the impact they and the company have on the environment.
- Consideration is taken to environmental aspects that affect the entire service life of the products.
- Environmental aspects are one of the parameters used during the selection of suppliers/contractors.
- Plans of action and contingency plans in consultation with the authorities concerned are available to limit/prevent the effects of any unintentional discharges or incidents.

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
